1 Intellectual property and property rights at the BC and in the Czech Republic

What are the guidelines for researchers at the BC? Can I publish first and patent later or vice versa? What is the proper procedure? What are the copyright and property rights in the Czech Republic? What is an invention? Should I report an invention and to whom? How much does a patent cost and how long does it take? What are the types of intellectual property rights? What is the BC intellectual property strategy? Are intellectual property costs eligible under the project? Shared intellectual property, how to process it? These questions and many more will be answered during the workshop.

3 Technology Transfer Office applied research projects management and support

What type of projects does TTO work on? What funding sources does TTO manage? What are the benefits of TTO's comprehensive project management for BC researchers? What kind of support does TTO provide? Can TTO assist with the application process? Will TTO provide project management services? How much money is in applied research calls? How many funding agencies are there in the Czech Republic? What are the national and European priorities and strategies for applied research? What is the societal relevance and impact? What types of results are eligible for funding? These tips and hints and much more will be part of this workshop.

2 Contracts regarding to know-how, IP, material transfer, licenses, classified information, contract research, collaboration, research outputs usage etc.

What kind of contracts can TTO help you with? What is MTA, NDA, CDA, MoA? What is license? I want to transfer biological material to an external subject; should I contract for it? Can I monetize it? What should be included in contracts for sharing know-how, intellectual property and research results? Who is authorized to sign the contracts at the BC? What is the internal approval process? Licensing best practices. Tips and hints and much more will be part of this workshop.
